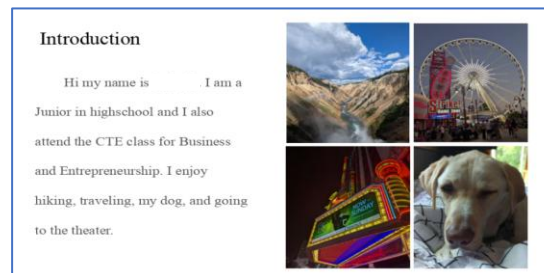
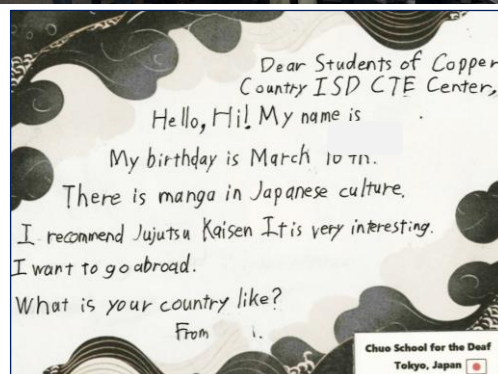
3. Counterpart

Tokyo Metropolitan Chuo School for the Deaf Card exchange with American friends

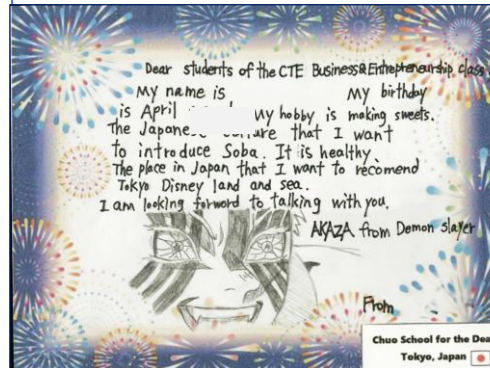

5. Additional information

- ◆ Both groups exchanged videos introducing their schools. The American schools added subtitles to their videos.
- ◆ Students paired up to share self-introduction cards. The Chuo School students shared about themselves and recommendations about Japan, while the American students also shared about themselves and about Japanese-made items they were familiar with.
- ◆ After two rounds of exchange, both groups showed interest in continuing video and teacher exchanges, indicating promising future collaboration.
