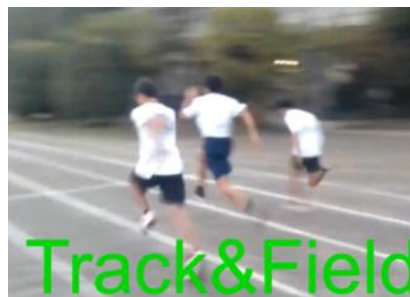

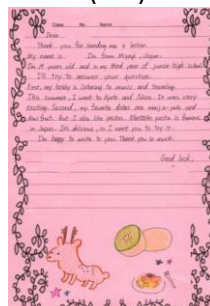
### 4. Schedule

### 5. Additional information

- ◆ The ZSOiO students created videos showing their school life and wrote detailed letters in English, including self-introductions and information about topics such as Polish food.
- ◆ The Tanashi No. 3 Junior High students wrote long English messages about their interests and daily lives, often with illustrations; some also introduced Nishitokyo City or their dreams.
- ◆ After reading the Tanashi No. 3 students' cards, the ZSOiO students wrote reply cards, addressing partners by nicknames and answering questions, leading to ongoing one-to-one exchange.
