## 5. Additional information

- ◆ The exchange was planned when a teacher from MacArthur High happened to visit Fuchie High. The teachers decided to use a cloud platform prepared by the MacArthur side for ongoing posts.
- ◆ Each month, a topic was set, and students shared messages with photos or illustrations. Because the MacArthur High students were learning Japanese, posts were written in both English and Japanese. Students easily replied to each other.
- ◆ Both sides exchanged gifts by mail and posted messages with photos expressing their thanks and impressions.
