- ◆ German food, sweets, buildings, Grimm fairy tales, soccer and more were highlighted in the presentation.
- ◆ The talk also highlighted the relationship between Japan and Germany along with German words often used in Japanese, such as *arubaito* (*Arbeit*, part-time work) and *karute* (*Karte*, medical records).
- ◆ After the presentation, there was a quiz on Germany. Students were surprised that the answer to “Something that Japanese schools have that German ones don’t,” was “Homework over summer break.”
