5. Additional information

- ◆ The Izumi Kodomoen children made a poster board that said “Welcome” in Spanish and displayed it the day of the visit to welcome the embassy visitors.
- ◆ The presenter used maps and videos to help the children easily understand Mexican geography and Mexico’s charms.
- ◆ After listening to the presentation, the children had fun answering six quiz questions. Students stood in front of an A or B when answering the questions and erupted into cheers if they answered correctly.
- ◆ After the quiz, the children tried playing hopscotch, a traditional Mexican game. The game was similar to a Japanese type of hopscotch, *kenkenpa*, allowing the children to have fun and easily learn the game.
