- ◆ The international instructors presented on their respective home countries in English. Content included history, geography, greetings, and how their countries are seen by Japan. They also talked about the relationship between Japanese yen, U.S. dollars, and their home currencies, which gave the students and opportunity to deepen their understanding of different economic conditions.
