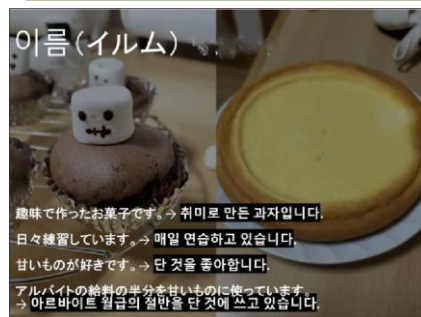

- ◆ The Kasaiminami students gave presentations in Japanese and Korean on their hobbies, holidays, and popular trends in Japan, with some students also mentioning part-time jobs or future aspirations.
- ◆ The Incheon Ara students presented in Japanese about their school life and after-school activities, introducing lessons, school events, daily routines, and including a short quiz and a video of their cultural festival.
- ◆ During the question-and-answer session, the Kasaiminami students were surprised to learn that Japanese language class hours for the Incheon Ara students may increase from 1 to 2 hours to up to 4 hours per week next year. The Korean students asked about school uniforms and were told there is no dress code. Each question was answered carefully in the small-group setting.
